Description of TV Footage about Russian Peacekeepers

15.08.2008. – Rustavi 2, Courier 9.00 (21-2 part)

Russian Peacekeepers loaded “Ural” type heavy trucks with stolen items, including 14 coast guard vessels.

16.08.2008 – Public Channel, 15:00

Russian peacekeepers continue looting coast guard buildings in Maltakva and Poti. They misappropriated military uniforms, furniture, duvets, mattresses, 2 power generators.

16.08.2008 – Public Channel, 20:00

Russian peacekeepers are looting not only military, but home appliances as well: furniture, fridges, duvets, cloths. All the trucks with looted items have identification marks of peacekeeping forces. It is easy to distinguish how Russian peacekeeper is stealing cloths from Poti port.

16.08.2008 – Rustavi 2, Courier, 15:00.

Another footage how Russian peacekeepers are looting Poti port and adjacent areas.

18.08.2008 – Public Channel, 12:00.

Russian peacekeepers are taking away stolen power generator and other items.

19.08.2008 – Public Channel, 12:00.

Russian peacekeepers are looting Zugdidi governmental residence.

21.08.2008 – Public Channel, 15:00, I part.

Russian peacekeepers are advancing in Samegrelo region and are standing at checkpoints.

21.08.2008 – Public Channel, 20:00, I part.

Russian peacekeepers are deployed close to Poti, at Nabada and have set up a checkpoint.

21.08.2008 – Public Channel, 10:00, I part.

Russian Peacekeepers are advancing in Samegrelo.

21.08.2008 – Rustavi2, Courier 10:00, I part.

Russian Peacekeepers at Nabada and Zugdidi Presidential Residence.

22.08.2008 - Public Channel, 15:00, 1 part.

Russian Peacekeepers are leaving presidential residence.

22.08.2008 - Public Channel, 16:00, 1 part.

Russian Peacekeepers are not allowing Matias Iorshi to enter Gori.

22.08.2008 - Public Channel, 20:00, 1 part.

Russian Peacekeepers are leaving Samegrelo region.

24.08.2008 - Rustavi2, Courier 15:00, 1 part. 24.08.2008 - Public Channel, 15:00 news.

Local population is protesting against Russian occupation in village Pirveli Maisi of Khobi district, the warning shots are made in the air by Russian soldiers. Russian APC with peacekeepers identification mark can be seen.
